The water we purify is given and sold to those who can afford it to offset filter costs. The solar system has been a huge blessing!



We are not slowing down in completing the needs of the mission. We are now looking to the next need by adding the second story of the school which will allow us to add the final grades of 10th to the 13th. Currently once the 9th grade has been completed, which is our last grade at the mission, most of the children end their education process. Melio is adamant that teaching Godliness and an education to the children is what will change the path of Haiti for its good.

The need is eight new school rooms which include a library, lab, high school study room and teachers room the government requires for high schoolers. The cost is \$7,950.00 per room for a total of \$63,600.00. Once the rooms are built we will have to build restrooms and handrails for the second-floor walkway. We will price that once the rooms are completed. God continues to open so many doors for the mission and I am so amazed at the way He works in so many hearts to provide for SCM. Imagine the dream God gave Melio while at his orphanage of going to collage to be a minister, start a mission with a church, school and medical clinic, and most of this blossoming since 2010. I stand in awe of Melio's faith, but most of all Gods great power and love!
