Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus,

It is a privilege for me to be able to send this out to you, proclaiming the goodness of God and all the wonderful blessings He is pouring out on the mission. The first blessing I want to share is Melio and Gyna's trip to the states on June 13th to July 13th. Gyna was blessed to see her doctor and they gave her medicines to help her with her back pain and will return in January for evaluation. Melio was able to make it to several churches where he shared the good news of God and what he is doing at the mission. The second blessing is, during Melio's trip he proclaimed the need to expand the school to its final phase to complete all grades to the 13th grade. Last quarters newsletter, I reported we needed eight rooms at a cost of \$7,950 per room. Unfortunately, I misunderstood the quote as it left out the cost of the roof, steps, handrails, and additional bathrooms which brings the total to \$12,500.0 per room. God pricked many hearts on Melio's trip and to date we have received funds or pledges to pay for five- and one-half rooms! I praise God for this and know He will find others to provide the remaining need. We also had one church provide \$24,000.00 to pay for the first year's cost to add the 10th grade. God is absolutely "SO" good. Please continue praying for the safety of Melio, the mission and all God's children in Haiti who are in harm's way daily due to the gangs. I know God's hand of protection is on them.
